Thailand Visa/Entry Requirements:

International travellers to Thailand should arrange for entry visas prior to travel at the closest Thai Embassy or Consulate. Some nationalities can obtain a visa on arrival at Bangkok Suvarnabhumi International Airport. Please kind check the specific visa requirements for your country.

Arrival & Departure Days:

Participants are advised to arrive in Bangkok by Monday, 20 January 2025, and depart on or after Friday, 24 January 2025.



Airport Transfer:

Airport pick-up and drop-off is arranged. Upon arrival at Suvarnabhumi International Airport, after passing the immigration check point and baggage claim, please proceed towards the meeting point at Gate 3 where our representative will meet you with RIMES logo signage.

Weather:

January in Bangkok is pleasantly warm and less humid, with daytime temperatures around 26–30°C and nighttime temperatures around 20–24°C. Rain is rare during this month.

Dress Code:

Business-casual attire is recommended for the workshop.

Please avoid wearing sports shoes and t-shirts.

- Currency: Thai Baht (THB)
- Current Exchange Rate: Approximately 1 USD = 34.763 THB (as of January 2025).
